Located in Dover, the c. 1875 Carpenter Gothic gatehouse building was built by the Dover Cemetery Association. The Gatehouse was also known as the "Receiving House" and the "Old Cemetery House" and is a rare surviving example of the Carpenter Gothic style in the Town of Dover. The grant will provide Phase 1: foundation rebuilding and structural upgrades of the Gatehouse.

The Millington Schoolhouse was built in 1845-1853 as a one-room schoolhouse. It has served the Township of Long Hill as a school, church, library, courthouse, meeting place, police headquarters, and town hall. The building is individually listed on the NJ and National Registers. The grant will assist with basement waterproofing including stormwater management, stone retaining walls.

The c. 1820 Phoenix House is a Federal style building that originally served as an inn along Washington Turnpike. The portico was added in 1840. The building was documented by HABS (Historic American Buildings Survey) in 1936. The Phoenix House is currently used as a Municipal building for the Borough of Mendham. The grant will provide exterior restoration and repairs and site drainage upgrades.

The c. 1825 banked English barn is listed on the National and New Jersey Registers as part of the individually listed Stephen Cary House property. The property was continuously farmed until the 1990s, and in 2015 the Borough of Mendham purchased 10.5 acres, which included the barn. The grant will provide barn rehabilitation including roofing, structural upgrades, and interior and exterior lighting.

The 2-room schoolhouse was built in the 1860s and was the first to service Brookside. The building was moved in 1923 to its current location and it has been used as a public meeting and event space ever since. An addition was built in the 1940s and it sustained fire damage in 1959. The building is contributing to the Brookside National Register District. The grant will restore the Bell Tower.

The 1848 stone grist mill was converted to a cider mill and distillery in 1910 and features a unique internal water wheel and turbine power transfer system. The mill and equipment have been substantially restored, making it the only authentic historic cider mill in New Jersey. The grant will provide roof replacement at the mill addition building and prepare a site-wide maintenance plan.

The Gothic Revival Chapel was built in 1869. The site is contributing to the Morristown Historic District. The grant will provide exterior repairs including tower masonry repairs, hyphen re-roofing and chapel gable-end louvers repair.

The house is listed on the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places and has been owned and maintained by the DAR since 1923. The grant will provide system upgrades.

Built in 1919 as the Palace Theatre, the building is currently utilized as the Growing Stage Theatre for Young Audiences. Individually listed on the historic registers, the building witnessed American entertainment industry's evolution from live stage productions to film as it served as a venue for both. The grant will provide HVAC upgrades including the replacement of mechanical, electrical, and plumbing equipment.

Craftsman Farms is a 650-acre property owned by Gustav Stickley, a leader in the Arts and Crafts movement in the United States. It contributes to the National Historic Landmark district and the New Jersey Register. The North Cottage is one of three cottages on the property. The grant will provide exterior restoration of the North Cottage including replacement of severely deteriorated structural framing members.

The buildings are contributing in the Ledgewood Historic Park and Drakesville Historic District and listed on the National and New Jersey Registers. The grant will provide for interior restoration of the Store.

The property is identified as a Key Contributing resource in the German Valley National Register Historic District. The grant will provide a new crawl space entrance including a cellar door and frame.

Additions were constructed in 2019. The barn is listed on the NJ Register of Historic Places. The grant will prepare a Preservation Plan to guide the preservation, repair, and maintenance of the building.

The Chamberlain House was built in the 1870s in the Second Empire style. The house was occupied as a library from the 1960s until 1982, when it was acquired by the Township of Jefferson. It currently operates as a museum and headquarters for the Jefferson Township Historical Society. The grant will complete Construction Documents for exterior restoration of the building.

The grant will prepare a Preservation Plan to guide the preservation, repair, and maintenance of the building.

Built in 1937 for the Walter Reade cinema chain, the Community Theater was designed by Thomas W. Lamb, foremost U.S. theater designer in the first half of the 20th century. In 1994, the theater was refurbished for use as a performing arts venue. The grant will prepare an update to the 2014 Preservation Plan to include a summary of work since 2014 and recommendations for treatment.

The Vail House, part of Historic Speedwell, was built c. 1760 by Thomas Kinney. The grant will complete Construction Documents for structural stabilization and building restoration to its appearance c.1864.

The grant will update the 2011 Preservation Plan to record previous repairs, assess current conditions, and plan for future preservation needs.

The Mount Freedom Presbyterian Church was constructed in 1823 in the Greek Revival style and expanded in 1868. Expanded in 1868, the building is the second-oldest religious building in Randolph. The church is listed in the NJ and National Registers. The grant will prepare a Preservation Plan to guide the preservation, repair, and maintenance of the church and parsonage buildings.

The Barn and Store buildings were likely constructed in the mid-late 19th century. The grant will produce Construction Documents for Store and Barn restoration.

The grant will prepare Construction Documents for exterior and interior restoration including the tin ceiling.

The building was saved from demolition in 1963 and converted to a museum in 1965. The grant will prepare a Preservation Plan.
