Program Development Report: History Program Development Specialist Palatucci reported that the 2023 re-grant applications have been reviewed, awarded, and distributed to grantees. This year there were a majority of GOS requests. This year the amount requested was \$62,473.00 with a re-grant amount of \$51,000.00 available.
