

Here are the 3 ways you can vote in the upcoming Primary Election...

1. VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT



Registered voters can apply for a **vote-by-mail ballot** by following the instructions found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV** or contacting the Morris County Clerk at 973-285-6066.

Then, VOTE and RETURN your ballot one of the following ways:

- *Mail:* Your vote-by-mail ballot **MUST** be postmarked on or before **8:00 p.m. on June 7th** and be received by Morris County's Board of Elections on or before June 13th.
- *Secure Ballot Drop Box:* Place your vote-by-mail ballot in one of Morris County's 30 secure ballot drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on June 7th. Drop box locations can be found at **morriscountynj.gov/dropbox**.
- *Board of Elections Office:* Deliver your vote-by-mail ballot in person to the Morris County Board of Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. on June 7th, located at 10 Court St., 2nd Floor Morristown. Contact us at 973-285-6715 or elections@co.morris.nj.us.

2. IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING



This option enables registered voters to cast their ballot **in person, using a voting machine, during a three-day period prior to Primary Election Day**. You can choose to vote, in person, when it's most convenient for your schedule. Morris County is using the ExpressVote XL voting machine at early voting centers.

No matter where you live in the county, you can vote your specific ballot at any of Morris County's 8 designated in-person early voting locations. Find early voting locations at **morriscountynj.gov/earlyvoting**.

In-person early voting locations will be open Friday, June 3rd through Sunday, June 5th. Hours will be Friday-Saturday, 10:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. and Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.

No appointment is necessary. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

3. AT YOUR POLLING PLACE ON PRIMARY ELECTION DAY



Vote in person at your polling place, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. **on Election Day, Tuesday, June 7th**. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

Morris County voters will vote on the Sequoia Advantage voting machine at the polls.

Go to morriscountynj.gov/elections for your polling place, listed on the Election Day Polling Places page.

NOTE: Vote-by-mail ballots CANNOT be returned to your early voting location or polling place.
