**RESOLUTION AWARDING THE ARCHITECTURAL CONTRACT FOR
RESURFACING PAVEMENT AT THE PEER PLACE FAMILY COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris has determined that there is a need for professional architectural services to prepare plans for resurfacing pavement at the Peer Place Family Complex; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Operating Budget through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development are available for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris does hereby designate the firm of **LSEA Corporation** to prepare plans for resurfacing pavement at the Peer Place Family Complex **for the sum of \$10,500**, in accordance with the agreement for services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is on file in the office of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris with the Executive Director and is available for public review.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be published in the Daily Record, as required by law.
