RESOLUTION AWARDING EXTERIOR REPAIRS AND THE REPLACEMENT OF STORAGE ROOM DOORS AT THE GREEN POND VILLAGE COMPLEX

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris has determined that there is a need for exterior repairs and the replacement of storage room doors at the Green Pond Village Complex, Rockaway Township, NJ; and

WHEREAS, funds from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development are available to provide these improvements through the Capital Fund Program; and

WHEREAS, the attached bids were received, opened and read aloud on Thursday, September 21, 2017 at 10:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid received was submitted by **Howard Storer, LLC in the amount of \$17,600 with a unit price of \$900 per additional door;** and

WHEREAS, Herbst Musciano LLC recommends an award be made to **Howard Storer, LLC;** and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of Morris finds that the best interests of the Authority and the purpose of the New Jersey Local Public Contract Law would be served by awarding the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris that **Howard Storer, LLC** be awarded the exterior repairs and the replacement of the storage room doors at the Green Pond Village Complex.
