RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE ENTRY AND ACCESS SYSTEM AT INDIA BROOK VILLAGE BUILDING A

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris has determined that there is a need to obtain the services of a contractor to replace the entry and access system at India Brook Village Building A; and

WHEREAS, the services of a qualified contractor is necessary as the controller is no longer communicating to the system, therefore, tenants and visitors are not able to access the building; and

WHEREAS, such services as to be awarded, do not virtue of the dollar expenditure for services, require the letting of Public Bid under the New Jersey State Law; and

WHEREAS, Security Net Protection Services initially installed the current system approximately twenty years ago and is a current vendor for the Housing Authority who has performed repair services in an exemplary manner; and

WHEREAS, the most responsible proposal from Security Net Protection Systems was for a price of \$12,326.61 for India Brook Village Building A; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority wishes to accept the proposal from Security Net Protection Systems; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development as part of the CARES Act are available for this purpose; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority County of Morris that Security Net Protection Systems is hereby awarded the contract for the replacement of the entry and access system at India Brook Village Building A for the amount of \$12, 326.61.
