

RESOLUTION 2020 - 56

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR INTERCOM AND ACCESS
CONTROL SYSTEM AT THE HOUSING AUTHORITY
ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris has determined that there is a need to obtain the services of a contractor to install an intercom and access control system located at the Housing Authority Administrative Office; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Office has been closed to the public since March 16, 2020 at the onset of COVID-19, necessitating the need for a video intercom system for appointments and an access control system for staff to enter the building; and

WHEREAS, the services of a qualified contractor are necessary to install the equipment in order to prevent and reduce the spread of COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, such services as to be awarded, do not by virtue of the dollar expenditure involved for services, require the letting of a Public Bid under the New Jersey Contract Law; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible proposal was received by **Absolute Protective Systems, Inc.** at a total price of **\$6,565**; and

WHEREAS, funds from United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Cares Act Section 8 Administrative Fee are available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS. The Housing Authority desires to accept the proposal from **Absolute Protective Systems, Inc.**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that **Absolute Protective Systems, Inc.** is hereby awarded the contract for HVAC air duct cleaning for a total contract amount of **\$6,565**.
