Description:

Mine Hill Township acquired these two properties in 2011. They are located off Canfield Avenue at the municipal boundary with Randolph Township. The lands are predominantly forested and contain remnants of the region's historical mining activity. The properties are adjacent to the Dickerson Mine Tract, which contains over 200 acres of open space previously preserved with county trust fund assistance. Today, the properties expand the passive recreational opportunities on the adjacent site, including additional hiking and walking paths networks.
