Description:

Chatham Township acquired these two properties in 2024. They are located off Southern Boulevard adjacent to Nash Field Park, a popular local park with amenities including a playground, basketball court, bleachers and multiple fields. The larger property contains a tributary of Black Brook that drains to the Great Swamp National Wildlife Refuge and ultimately the Passaic River. Chatham Township manages both properties as passive open space and an addition to Nash Field Park.
