RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR SIDEWALK REPAIRS AT PEER PLACE AND PLEASANT VIEW VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority County of Morris has determined there is a need to obtain the services of a contractor to repair sidewalks and trip hazards at Peer Place Family Complex in Denville, NJ and Pleasant View Village Senior Complex in Rockaway, NJ; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority wishes to utilize an approved contractor pursuant to a fair and open process as defined by NJSA 19:44A-20.5 through the Educational Services Commission of New Jersey Contract #20/21-27; and

WHEREAS, a proposal was received by Always Safe Sidewalks, LLC, at a price in the amount of \$11,541.00 for Trip Hazard, Crack Repair and Expansion Joint Repair at Peer Place and \$1,955.00 for Trip Hazard, Crack Repair, Expansion Joint repair and Curb Repair at Pleasant View Village for a total of \$13,496.00; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority wishes to accept the proposal from Always Safe Sidewalks, LLC.; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development as part of the overall management budget, are available for this purpose; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority County of Morris that Always Safe Sidewalk, LLC is hereby awarded the contract for the sidewalk repairs at Peer Place and Pleasant View Village for the amount of \$13,496.00.
