Ms. Strater reported that the vacant apartment is almost finished. They only have to install the cabinets and countertop to finish the unit. We are going to move the other tenant in the upstairs apartment into the vacant unit in order to rehab the other two bedroom unit.

The contractor is still waiting for the permits from Morris Township for the garage renovation. The Township notified the Architect that we have to install sprinklers in all four units. This will be an additional \$20,000-\$25,000.

The bathroom is completed in the apartment at 227 Martin Luther King Avenue.

Property Adjacent to Morris Mews

Mr. Henshaw reported that the County is requesting certain insurance requirements. We contacted the JIF in order to provide the insurance information as they requested. The JIF provided the information and it was forwarded to the County of Morris. We are awaiting their response.
