Franklin Road Property

Ms. Strater reported that she was informed that we should look into a tax relief request with the Township of Randolph since this property cannot be developed due to the flood plain. This will be addressed with the Morris County Affordable Housing Corporation board.

New Business

Ms. Strater reported that this is the first year in many years that we received a score of 89 which makes us a Standard Performer. This is due to the fact that we have not had a Maintenance Supervisor for over a year.

Ms. Strater stated the Auditor completed the Audit for FY 2016 and found nothing wrong with the tenant files.

Ms. Strater informed the Board that she met with Ms. Keisha Moore, Associate Professor at Drew University and Mr. Russ Hall. Mr. Hall is working with Ms. Moore through the COCC to look at the chronic homeless population. Ms. Moore is doing a landlord survey to find landlords that are willing to accept Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers for the homeless population. They are requesting the Housing Authority to review the names of the landlords that are on the State Rental Assistance program to see if any of those names are on our program. Ms. Strater will discuss this with Mr. Henshaw for his legal opinion.

Commissioner Hall explained this activity in detail to the Board members.
