RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR TELEPHONE ENTRY SYSTEM AND ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM AT MORRIS MEWS SENIOR CITIZEN COMPLEX AND DEAN A. GALLO CONGREGATE LIVING FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Morris has determined that there is a need to obtain the services of a contractor to install a Telephone Entry System and Access Control System located at Morris Mews Senior Citizen Complex (Buildings 1-5) and the Dean A. Gallo Congregate Living Facility; and

WHEREAS, the complex experienced a lightning strike on June 4, 2021, affecting the intercom and entry system, necessitating the need to upgrade the current system for tenants and visitors to enter the buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority wishes to utilize an approved contractor pursuant to a fair and open process as defined by NJSA 19:44A-20.5 through the NJ State Contract, Vendor ID V00000876; and

WHEREAS, a proposal was received by Main Access Systems, at a price in the amount of \$16,990.00 to furnish and install the Telephone Entry System, \$15,900.00 to furnish and install the Access Control System and \$825.00 for Key Fobs for a total price of \$33,715.00; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and insurance reimbursement from the Joint Insurance Fund (JIF) are available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority desires to accept the proposal from Main Access Systems; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Main Access Systems, is hereby awarded the contract for installation of Telephone Entry System and Access Control System for a total contract amount of \$33,715.00.
