

WHAT IS THE MORRIS AREA PARATRANSIT SYSTEM (MAPS)?

We are a curb-to-curb shared ride transportation service available to Morris County residents. The MAPS curb-to-curb shared ride service is limited to senior citizens (60 years of age or older), people with disabilities, veterans, and the general public who reside in rural areas of the county.

MAPS also provides a shuttle service between various county offices. This is available to all Morris County residents.

MAPS provides feeder service to NJ TRANSIT Bus and Rail. MAPS may also provide travel five miles into contiguous counties.

Shopping Guidelines

GROCERY SHOPPING STANDARDS

- Grocery Shopping trips will be provided Monday to Friday 10am to 1pm.
- Grocery shopping will be scheduled on demand, no subscriptions will be created.
- Reservations may be made between one business day and one month in advance.
- Grocery bags will be limited to three (3) per rider, and must be able to be lifted/carried by the rider.
- Grocery bags may not exceed the dimension/size of 15"W x 16"H x 8"D.
- No oversized bags/boxes/items will be permitted.
- Drivers may assist with loading and unloading bags from the vehicle only. Bags will not be carried to doorstep.
