#### Who is a Veteran?

Title 38 of the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations defines as:

"a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable."

This definition explains that any individual that completed a service for any branch of the Armed Forces classifies as a Veteran as long as they were not dishonorably discharged. However, certain programs and benefits may have additional criteria for eligibility.

# 7 Tips for Veterans

- 1. Make copies of discharge papers and advise family members & caregivers where they can be found.
- 2. Obtain a County Veterans Identity Card at the <u>Office of the Morris County Clerk</u>, <a href="https://morriscountyclerk.org/index.php/services/id-cards/">https://morriscountyclerk.org/index.php/services/id-cards/</a>.
- 3. Seek information directly from the service provider.
- 4. Not all Veterans are eligible for every benefit.
- 5. Unsure if you're eligible for benefits? Ask! This is what we are here for.
- 6. Already receiving Veteran's benefits and moving? Update your information with VA.gov 800-827-1000.
- 7. For GI Bill Education Benefits, contact the Veterans Representative at the institution you are attending.
