***Who is a Veteran?***

Title 38 of the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations defines as:

*“a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.”*

This definition explains that any individual that completed a service for any branch of the Armed Forces classifies as a Veteran as long as they were not dishonorably discharged. However, certain programs and benefits may have additional criteria for eligibility.

***7 Tips for Veterans***

1. Make copies of discharge papers and advise family members & caregivers where they can be found.
2. Obtain a County Veterans Identity Card at the [Office of the Morris County Clerk](https://morriscountyclerk.org/index.php/services/id-cards/), <https://morriscountyclerk.org/index.php/services/id-cards/>.
3. Seek information directly from the service provider.
4. Not all Veterans are eligible for every benefit.
5. Unsure if you're eligible for benefits? Ask! This is what we are here for.
6. Already receiving Veteran's benefits and moving? Update your information with [VA.gov](https://va.gov) 800-827-1000.
7. For GI Bill Education Benefits, contact the Veterans Representative at the institution you are attending.
