- 3. Executive Session: No Executive Session requested.

Agenda Item (ii) was discussed – Resolution authorizing the payment of Solar II expenses. Commissioner Ramirez made a motion to adopt this resolution. Commissioner Sandman seconded the motion. Roll was called. The resolution was unanimously approved. "RESOLUTION OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN OPERATING EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY'S COUNTY OF MORRIS GUARANTEED RENEWABLE ENERGY PROGRAM LEASE REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2011 AND CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO" (No. 24-30) was adopted.

Agenda Item (iii) was discussed - Resolution approving the payment of bills as listed on the Schedule of Warrants in the amount of \$6,196.40. Commissioner Ramirez made a motion to adopt this resolution. Commissioner Sandman seconded the motion. Roll was called. The resolution was unanimously approved. Resolution "Bill List" (No. 24-31) was adopted.
