RESOLUTION OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL FINANCE BOARD PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-6

WHEREAS, the Morris County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") desires to make application to the Local Finance Board for its review pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-6 of a bond resolution authorizing the issuance of County of Morris and Township of Hanover Guaranteed Governmental Revenue Bonds (Whippany Firehouse Project), Series 2019, in one or more series (inclusive of any project notes issued in anticipation thereof), the proceeds of which will be used by the Authority to refinance the acquisition of certain property and finance and refinance, as applicable, the design, construction, equipping and furnishing of a new firehouse on behalf of Fire District #2 of the Township of Hanover, in the County of Morris, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Authority believes that:

- (a) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose;
- (b) said purpose or improvements are for the health, welfare, convenience or betterment of the inhabitants of the local unit or units;
- (c) the amounts to be expended for said purpose or improvements are not unreasonable or exorbitant; and
- (d) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the local unit or units and will not create an undue financial burden to be placed upon the local unit or units.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The application to the Local Finance Board is hereby approved, and the Authority's Bond Counsel, along with other representatives of the Authority, are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the Authority in matters pertaining thereto.
- **Section 2.** The Secretary of the Authority is hereby directed to prepare and cause Bond Counsel to the Authority to file a copy of this resolution with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.

Section 3. The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its findings and recommendations as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statutes.

Section 4. Subject to the second sentence of this section, this resolution shall take effect immediately. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:37A-50, the Secretary of the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to submit to each member of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "*Board of Freeholders*"), by the end of the fifth business day following this meeting, a copy of the minutes of this meeting. The Secretary is hereby further authorized and directed to obtain from the Clerk of the Board of Freeholders a certification from the Clerk stating that the minutes of this meeting have not been vetoed by the Director of the Board of Freeholders.
