NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Authority as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Authority hereby appoints the following persons to the following respective offices of the Authority:
 - a. Chairperson: John Bonanni
 - b. Vice-Chairperson: Christina Ramirez
 - c. Treasurer: Joseph A. Kovalcik, Jr.
 - d. Secretary: Ellen Sandman
 - e. Assistant Secretary: Scott Gallopo.

Section 2. Such officers are hereby severally authorized and directed to discharge the rights, duties and obligations of their respective offices to the extent provided for under applicable law, including the Act and in accordance with the provisions of the by-laws of the Authority adopted by resolution no. 02-13 on August 14, 2002 and entitled "RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", as amended by resolution no. 04-18 on June 9, 2004 and entitled "RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", as amended by

resolution no. 05-21 on October 11, 2005 and entitled, "RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", from the date of adoption of this resolution at the Authority's 2017 annual meeting through the Authority's 2018 annual meeting to be held in February, 2018.

Section 3. Subject to the second sentence of this section, this resolution shall take effect immediately. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:37A-50, the Secretary of the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to submit to each member of the Board of Freeholders, by the end of the fifth business day following this meeting, a copy of the minutes of this meeting.
