RESOLUTION OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SCHEDULE OF REGULAR MONTHLY MEETINGS FOR THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE BALANCE OF CALENDAR YEAR 2023 AND EARLY 2024 THROUGH AND INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY'S 2024 ANNUAL MEETING, INCLUDING THE MEDIUM IN WHICH SUCH MEETINGS SHALL BE CONDUCTED

WHEREAS, the Morris County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") has been duly created by resolution no. 42 entitled, "Resolution of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of Morris County, New Jersey creating the Morris County Improvement Authority" duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board of County Commissioners") of the County of Morris (the "County") in the State of New Jersey (the "State") on April 10, 2002, as a public body corporate and politic of the State pursuant to and in accordance with the county improvement authorities law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1960 of the State, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto (the "Act") and other applicable law; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act and the Open Public Meetings Act, constituting Chapter 231 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1975 of the State, as amended from time to time (codified at *N.J.S.A.* 10:4-1 *et seq.*, the "Open Public Meetings Act"), and Section 5.2 of the by-laws of the Authority adopted by resolution no. 02-13 on August 14, 2002, and entitled, "RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", as amended by resolution no. 04-18 on June 9, 2004, and entitled, "RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", as amended by resolution no. on October 11, 2005, and entitled, "RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", is amended by resolution no. on October 11, 2005, and entitled, "RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BY-LAWS OF THE MORRIS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY", the Authority desires to establish its monthly regular meeting schedule for the balance of the 2023 calendar year, and the beginning of the 2024 calendar year through and including the Authority's 2024 annual meeting in February of 2024, including the medium in which such meetings shall be conducted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Authority as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with the Act, the Open Public Meetings Act, the By-Laws and other applicable law, the Authority hereby establishes the following schedule of regular monthly meetings of the Authority for the balance of the 2023 calendar year through and including the Authority's 2024 annual meeting in February of 2024, including the medium in which such meetings shall be conducted, unless subsequently changed in accordance with such law:

March 15, 2023September 20, 2023 @ 3:00PMApril 19, 2023 @ 3:00PMOctober 18, 2023May 17, 2023November 13, 2023June 21, 2023 @ 3:00PMDecember 20, 2023July 18, 2023January 17, 2024August 16, 2023February 21, 2024 @ 3:00PM(includes 2024 Annual Meeting)

Section 2. Unless subsequently changed in accordance with the Act, the Open Public Meetings Act, the By-Laws and/or other applicable law, all such meetings shall be (i) open to the public, except for those portions for which executive session is permitted under such applicable law; (ii) held at 5:00 p.m. (except as may be noted above); and, (iii) shall be held in a hybrid fashion, both virtually via Cisco WebEx, and in person in the Knox Conference Room, 5th Floor, Morris County Administration Building, Morristown, New Jersey, and in accordance with appropriate notice and participation instructions to be furnished pursuant to and in accordance with all applicable law.

Section 3. The Chairperson is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post said schedule, including the medium in which such meetings shall be conducted, and make said schedule generally available to the public upon request, all in accordance with the Act, the Open Public Meetings Act, the By-Laws and all other applicable law.

Section 4. The promulgation of a 2023-2024 schedule for regular meetings, including the medium in which such meetings shall be conducted, does not preclude the Authority from calling special or emergency meetings in accordance with the By-Laws, the Act, the Open Public Meetings Act and all other applicable law, or from subsequently changing the medium in which such meetings, whether regular, special or emergency, shall be conducted.

Section 5. Subject to the second sentence of this Section, this resolution shall take effect immediately. In accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 40:37A-50, the Secretary of the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to submit to each member of the Board of County Commissioners, by the end of the fifth business day following this meeting, a copy of the minutes of this meeting. The Secretary is hereby further authorized and directed to obtain from the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners a certification from the Clerk stating that the minutes of this meeting have not been vetoed by the Director of the Board of County Commissioners.
