# Transitioning to the new radio system

Spring 2023

#### On the effective date

Sometime in early 2023

- All communications currently taking place on talkgroup "Fire Response x" in the UHF-F A1 zone, will be transitioned to the new county radio system. Several changes to naming and use will commence at this time. At the designated time, users should push the "Home" button on their mobile and portable radios to take them to channel 1 in the "FD Primary" zone. Then utilize the channel selector to move to your "MC FIRE x" talkgroup. This will be your everyday channel going forward. Referred to as "Morris Fire x".
- i.e. Fire Response 3 today will become MC FIRE 3 on the new system.

## Home button

Takes you to FD Primary zone, channel 1





# Set your Primary, everyday channel

Press and **hold** to **set** for your primary zone/channel if different from HOME.

Press once to go to this channel

from any other zone/channel



# Changes to procedure

- On scene communications: *continue* to utilize "Fireground 1-4" in position 13-16. No permission is required to use these channels.
- Mutual Aid events requiring long distance communications for command: (formerly OPS1-9)
  - If you are the "host agency", you will remain on your primary MC Fire channel, or be assigned a PS TAC channel, and outside responding units will be directed to that talkgroup. This channel is NOT for on-scene/interior operations, but for response, command and control with mutual aid units and county dispatch.
  - If you are a responding agency responding to another jurisdiction, you will be directed by dispatch to the appropriate "MC Fire" or "PS TAC" talkgroup. This channel is NOT for on-scene/interior operations, but response, command and control with the host IC, other mutual aid units and county dispatch.
  - If your primary assigned "MC FIRE" talkgroup is already in use by another entity with a major event, you will be directed by dispatch to an alternate "MC FIRE" or "PS TAC" talkgroup for any separate, concurrent incident. Be sure to listen to your page to hear any deviation from your normal channel.

# Changes page 2

- Incidents at Morristown Airport, or in the Route 287/24 corridor: (formerly OPS2) utilize the "HWY/AIRPT" talkgroup in the "TAC" zone, channel 8 (one up from FD Primary). Set a MS button for easy access for frequent use.
- Interoperability with EMS units or planned events requiring long distance communications: (formerly OPS1-9) contact dispatch for assignment of a "PS TAC" or "F/E TAC" channel in the "TAC" zone (one up from FD Primary).

# Changes page 3

- Interoperability with Police units: (formerly OPS10-25) contact dispatch for assignment of a "PS TAC" in the "TAC" zone, channels 1-7 (one up from FD Primary).
- Fire units NOT dispatched by Morris County who are responding to an incident outside of their town, or who need mutual aid to their town: (formerly Fire MA) contact county dispatch on MIRS (TAC zone channel 16) for assignment of a "MC FIRE" or "PS TAC" channel for the incident.

# Changes page 4

- If you did not hear the assignment via page, need to establish a channel assignment, or to contact other dispatch centers (within Morris County), call on the "MIRS" talkgroup, channel 16 in the "TAC" zone.
- Set a MS button for MIRS for quick, easy access.


# Changing zones

Increase 1 at a time	Select menu to scroll through all zones	Decrease 1 at a time

For ease of operation, the MS1-MS5 buttons (use U/D/L/R button to move one screen to the right) on the mobile menu (MS1-MS3 on portables) can be preset by the user for frequently used channels in any zone.

- You can also program any channel from any zone into the Dynamic Zone so that you can always remain in that zone with your most frequently used/needed channels.
- You can have as many channels as you want in this zone in mobile units, but only 16 on portables
- Move to the Dynamic zone and use the ZNPR button to add/delete channels



## FYI (for further discussion)

- Mutual Aid out of County contact Comm Center for assignment of a UTAC or UASI channel
- Comm Center patching channels can be done for disparate systems, but in most cases, users should have necessary channels in their radios
- Dynamic Regrouping radios can be forced to another talkgroup
  if they are unable to find it
