



SECTION 9. JURISDICTIONAL ANNEXES

Section 201.6.a(4) of Chapter 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations (44CFR) states: “Multi-jurisdictional plans (e.g. watershed plans) may be accepted, as appropriate, as long as each jurisdiction has participated in the process and has officially adopted the plan.” One component of each participating jurisdiction’s involvement in the planning process of this HMP was to prepare an annex that focuses specifically on the natural hazards facing their community and the mitigation actions they propose to reduce their exposure and losses to these hazards.

Morris County and each participating jurisdiction completed an annex that outlines the following information: natural hazard event history, hazard ranking and vulnerability, capabilities, progress on past mitigation actions and an updated mitigation strategy specific to the County or that jurisdiction. Once complete, the County and each participating jurisdiction reviewed and approved their final annex prior to submission to the NJOEM and the FEMA Region 2. Each jurisdiction’s annex itself may be found in Sections 9.1 through 9.40.
