SUMMARY OF BENEFITS FOR EIGHT YEAR FARMLAND PRESERVATION PROGRAMS

Municipally Approved Programs

- 1. Eligible to apply to the CADB to sell a development easement on the land included.
- 2. Eligible to apply, or have a farm operator apply to the local soil conservation district and the CADB for a grant for a soil and water conservation project.
- 3. To use farm structure designs based on criteria developed by a land grant college and approved by the SADC.
- 4. Protection for eleven (11) years from the effective date of the municipally approved program against a municipality altering its zoning ordinance such that it has the practical effect of exclusive agricultural zoning.
- 5. There shall exist an irrefutable presumption that no agricultural operation, activity or structure located on the property and which conforms to agricultural management practices (N.J.A.C. 2:76-2) and which does not pose a direct threat to public health and safety shall constitute a public or private nuisance.
- 6. Agricultural activities are exempt from any emergency restrictions placed on water or energy use unless declared otherwise by the Governor.
- 7. Additional benefits as determined by the CADB.
- 8. Additional benefits as may be made available from time to time through amendments to the State, County and municipal laws, rules, or policies.
- 9. Protection from eminent domain takings.

Non-Municipally Approved Program

- 1. Eligible to apply to the CADB to sell a development easement on the land included.
- 2. Eligible to apply, or have a farm operator apply to the local soil conservation district and the CADB for a grant for a soil and water conservation project.
