COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS LAW

NEW BUSINESS

SADC: draft soil protection standards. Ms. Coyle informed the Board that the SADC had released the draft soil protection standards to all stakeholders for review and comment. Comments are due by June 18th. The draft document was forwarded to the Board prior to the meeting. Ms. Coyle provided the background information about the proposal.

Mr. Anthony Sposaro shared with the Board his concerns/questions about the proposal:

- Will the standards apply retroactively (to farms that are already preserved)?
- Could farmers be required to remove existing improvements?
- Will the new standards have a negative impact on enrollment in the Farmland Preservation Program?
- The standards should only apply prospectively. Farm owners should be allowed to keep existing improvements and the new restrictions should apply to new improvements.

The Board discussed their concerns about the proposal. Members of the Board of Agriculture agreed that they would invite SADC staff to attend their June meeting to present the draft soil protection standards. Members of the CADB will be invited to attend the Board of Agriculture meeting to hear the presentation (the SADC last presented the proposal to the CADB in 2019).
