Do you want your property to be added to the Draft Future Sewer Service Area (SSA) because of a malfunctioning septic system and it is located in an area with documented malfunctioning septic systems?

If so, here's what you must do:

1.) Obtain verification and documentation that the septic system is in fact malfunctioning (and <u>not</u> as a result of a lack of system maintenance) from your County or local Health Department.

Your property must be contiguous to the previously adopted SSA and wastewater conveyance infrastructure. If your property is not contiguous to the adopted SSA, in addition to #1 above, you must initiate discussion with your municipality, Hunterdon County, and the NJ Department of Environmental Protection to discern the potential for connection.
