The general nature of the subject to be discussed is as follows: Purchase, lease or acquisition of real property. The meeting reopened to the public at 9:36 P.M.

ACTION AS A RESULT OF CLOSED SESSION

1. Township of Jefferson - "Babbling Brooke"

On a motion by Don Travisano, seconded by Barbara Shepard, the committeerecommended a second grant extension for the project. A roll call vote was taken.Aye: Donadio, Engelbart, Gindoff, Kanigel, Nametko, Piserchia, Shepard, Travisano,WatsonNay: NoneAbstain: None

- Borough of Lincoln Park "Midwood Flood Storage Area Addition" On a motion by Don Travisano, seconded by Tom Donadio, the committee recommended Robert Schwarz, MAI perform an appraisal of the property (land only) to determine Morris County Accepted Market Value (AMV) and maximum potential grant. A roll call vote was taken. Aye: Donadio, Engelbart, Gindoff, Kanigel, Nametko, Piserchia, Shepard, Travisano, Watson Nay: None Abstain: None
- 3. <u>Site Visit and Final Applicant Presentation Schedule</u> Ms. Murray circulated the sign-up sheets for the site visits and reviewed the final presentation schedule with the committee. Ms. Murray indicated the committee's policy is to require each member to visit at least 40% of the sites to participate in deliberations. Members can visit sites on their own to attain the attendance requirement.
- 4. <u>Report of Recent Trust Fund Closings</u> Ms. Murray reviewed the recent trust fund closings with the committee.
- 5. <u>Discussion P.L. 2017, chapter 154 expands definition of "acquisition" for county</u> <u>and municipal open space trust funds</u> - Ms. Murray stated the this law passed in July

2017 amends P.L. 1997, Chapter 24 (a.k.a. N.J.S.A. 40:12-19) and expands the definition of 'acquisition' for county and municipal trust funds to specify that the term includes demolition, debris removal and restoration of lands to a natural state. The goal of the amendment was to resolve any differing interpretations or application, which may be currently occurring at the local level regarding the definition of the term. Under the new full definition, "Acquisition" or "acquire" means the securing of a fee simple or lesser interest in land, including but not limited to an easement restricting development, by gift, purchase, installment purchase agreement, devise, or condemnation, *and includes the demolition of structures on, the removal of debris from, and the restoration of those lands to a natural state or to a state useful for recreation and conservation purposes.*"

John Napolitano stated since the Rules and Regulations of the Trust Fund are based on Chapter 24, the definition of 'acquisition' must be amended, but it is at the County's discretion as to whether to fund these additional items. In addition, the County's Flood Mitigation Program (FMP) is considering whether to fund these additional items under it rules. Members discussed the amended definition in relation to the open space program. There was concern over the term 'restoration of the lands to a natural state or to a state useful for recreation and conservation purposes.' Remediation of soil contamination for these purposes could render a project very costly, and there is ambiguity what agency determines what is deemed 'useful.' The county could also define what it deems this to mean under the various programs. It was agreed that each program under the Preservation Trust Fund could use different definitions and to take no action on the matter at this time.

NEXT MEETING DATE

The committee will reconvene for applicant presentations on Monday, October 23, 2017 beginning at 6:00 P.M. at the County Library located at 30 East Hanover Avenue in Whippany, NJ.
