Description:

These five properties totaling 3.7 acres are located west of the Pompton River, east of Route 23. The properties are part of a larger Army Corps of Engineers program allocated for the greater Passaic River floodplain, for the Preservation of Natural Flood Storage Areas and Floodway Buyout. Acquisition of these lands will fill in the gaps between existing preserved lands, and further the goal of creating a linear park along the Pompton River. At the present time the Township is under contract with several of the landowners.
