

**Morris County Board of Taxation**  
**January 15, 2026, Meeting Minutes**

The Morris County Board of Taxation met in its office at 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown, New Jersey, on January 15, 2026, at 10:01 A.M. Commissioner President Kersey presided. Commissioners, Vice President Ramirez and Parmigiani were present. Commissioner Kincaid was absent. Also present were Patricia Marsh, County Tax Administrator, and Frances Castro, Tax Researcher, Examiner & Investigator.

Commissioner President Kersey announced that proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with County Clerk, the Daily Record the Star Ledger.

The minutes of the December 18, 2025, meeting were adopted on a motion by Commissioner Vice President Ramirez, seconded by Commissioner Parmigiani; all were in favor.

**Public Input:**

The public portion of the meeting was opened and closed without comment.

**Business:**

On motion by Commissioner Ramirez, seconded by Commissioner Parmigiani the Reassessment application for the Borough of Rockaway was approved.

A discussion was held regarding municipalities being considered for revaluation, specifically Boonton Township and Florham Park. It was requested that this matter be placed on the agenda for discussion at the February 19, 2026, meeting.

The Board approved the tax list certification for 39 municipalities, on motion by Commissioner Ramirez and seconded by Commissioner Parmigiani.

The following educational conferences were approved for attendance by Commissioners and office staff, subject to approval by the Tax Administrator: Northeastern Regional Association of Assessing Officers Conference; the New Jersey League of Municipalities Conference; the International

Association of Assessing Officers Conference; and the New Jersey Association of County Tax Boards Conference.
