

Morris County Board of Taxation February 17, 2022 Meeting Minutes

The Morris County Board of Taxation met in its office at 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown, New Jersey on February 17, 2022 at 10:00 A.M.

President Dr. Michael DiFazio presided and Commissioners Kersey was present via conference call. Commissioner Ramirez was absent.

Also present: Patricia Marsh, Administrator and Nicolle Krake.

President Dr. DiFazio announced the proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record, the Star Ledger and the Record.

On motion by Commissioner Kersey seconded by Commissioner DiFazio the minutes of January 20, 2022 were approved.

No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

Business: The Board heard and considered the Rollback Tax Complaint filed by Township of Roxbury. Judgment was entered fixing the amount on which the Rollback taxes will be computed as submitted by the municipality. The Board received Morristown's signed contract with Appraisal Systems for their Revaluation to be completed by September 30, 2022 for the tax year 2023. The signed contract will be sent to the State for approval. The 2022 Preliminary Equalization Table for the County of Morris for 2022 was presented by the Tax Administrator, Patricia Marsh, she announced that the proper and timely notice had been posted and filed with the County Clerk in accordance with the "Sunshine Law", the Daily Record and the Star Ledger were notified via facsimile. Copies of the table were sent to each municipality, the assessor and clerk, the Director of the Division of Taxation, the County Treasurer, The County Administrator, the Commissioners

and also posted in the public area of the Tax Board Office.

On motion by Commissioner Kersey and seconded by Commissioner DiFazio Preliminary Table was accepted. There being no objections to the Preliminary Table, on motion by Commissioner Kersey and seconded by Commissioner DiFazio the Final 2022 Equalization Table was adopted as prepared by the Tax Administrator.

On motion by Commissioner Kersey and seconded by Commissioner DiFazio the Board cancelled the March 10, 2022 meeting.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:00.
