## Morris County Board of Taxation June 17, 2021 Minutes

The Morris County Board of Taxation met at its office on 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown, New Jersey on June 17, 2021 at 10:00 A.M.

President Dr. Michael DiFazio presided.

Also present: Patricia Marsh, Tax Administrator and Nicolle Krake

President Dr. DiFazio announced the proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record, the Star Ledger and the Record.

On Motion Commissioner Dr. DiFazio approved the minutes for February 18, April 15 and May 3, 2021 and approved judgments for all 2021 Tax Appeals.

No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

Business: Jack Marchione, Assessor, Fred Semrau Esq., Special Tax Council, and Jason Cohn, from ASI for the Mount Arlington Borough to update the Board on the Status of their municipal wide revaluation ordered to be completed for the tax year 2021. The borough was given an extension to be completed for the tax year 2022 due to problems getting their tax maps approved. The borough is requesting another extension due to tax maps that are not yet completed and they need time to do the interior inspections. The Board granted the extension to be completed for the tax year 2023.

Irene Stefanacci, Assessor and Fred Semrau, Esq., Special Council for Denville Township and Paul Tannenbaum, Esq., council for Toll NJ LLC appeared before the Board requesting to amend a Tax Appeal judgement. The Township and the Toll NJ LLC agreed on a revised assessment.

The Board reviewed the request and amended the judgment.

After review the Board approved the Applications for Reassessment submitted by the Mountain Lakes Borough and Mendham Township to be completed for the 2022 tax year.

The Board approved to pay the Hotel and Registration for the Morris County Tax Assessors to attend the NJACTB Annual Educational Conference 8/30/21 – 9/3/21 in Cape May, New Jersey. The Board approved attendance at the following Education Conferences/Seminars for the Commissioners, Tax Administrator and office staff: NJACTB Annual Educational Conference 8/30/21 – 9/3/21 Cape May, New Jersey and NJ League of Municipalities 11/16/21 – 11/18/21 Atlantic City, New Jersey.

The Board approved the purchase of a tote bag item as well as a raffle basket to be donated to the annual New Jersey Association of County Tax Boards annual education conference.
