Morris County Board of Taxation September 10, 2020 Minutes

The Morris County Board of Taxation met in its office at 30 Schuyler Place, Morristown, New Jersey on September 10, 2020 at 10:00 A. M.

President Dr. DiFazio announced the proper and timely notice of the meeting had been posted and filed with the County Clerk, the Daily Record, the Star Ledger and the Record. No one from the public was present. That portion of the meeting devoted to the public was closed.

Borough of Riverdale to be effective for the 2021 Tax Year.
