WHEREAS, the Morris County Board of County Commissioners believes it is important to patronize our local small businesses and honor the significant contributions they make to our economy, community and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the United States Small Business Administration (SBA) reported in June 2025 that there are 36.2 million small businesses in the United States, and according to 2024 statistics, account for 99.9 percent of all businesses in the United States and employ approximately 46 percent of private sector workers, or about 59 million people; and

**WHEREAS**, the SBA also estimated small businesses were responsible for creating 20.2 million net new jobs, or 61.1 percent of all net new jobs in the U.S., since 1995; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic took a devastating toll on our small businesses during 2020, forcing hundreds of thousands to permanently close, according to the SBA; however, small business employment grew quickly afterwards, recovering the lost jobs by the Third Quarter of 2022 and adding another 1.6 million jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Saturday after Thanksgiving has become known as "Small Business Saturday" since it was launched by American Express on November 27, 2010, and it has since grown into a national campaign to encourage holiday shoppers to patronize local businesses; and since the campaign's inception, total spending has reached \$223 billion; and

WHEREAS, reported projected spending among U.S. consumers who shopped at independent retailers and restaurants on Small Business Saturday in 2024 reached an estimated \$22 billion, according to the 2024 Small Business Saturday Consumer Insights Survey commissioned by American Express; and

WHEREAS, 85 percent of U.S. consumers aware of Small Business Saturday shopped or ate at a small, independently owned retailer or restaurant on Small Business Saturday in 2024, and 66 percent of shoppers surveyed strongly agree that they found a small business or independently owned restaurant on Small Business Saturday where they are likely to return and become a regular customer.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MORRIS TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN TO PROVIDE COST ASSISTANCE TO MORRISTOWN TO REVIEW PLANS AND PROVIDE INSPECTIONS FOR THE NEW COUNTY COURTHOUSE

WHEREAS, the County of Morris (the "County") is the owner of certain real property located at Block 5905 Lot 5 located at the corner of the intersection of 32 Washington and Schuyler Place (the "Courthouse") in the Town of Morristown (the "Town"), County of Morris, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the County is in the process of building a new County courthouse in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the County is not required to pay for building permit fees, but has agreed to contribute to the Town Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to assist with the costs for plan review and inspections by the Town and to help defray the costs to the Town associated with the large size of this legacy project; and

**WHEREAS**, being in accordance with the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., local units may join together to provide authorized services for each other.

Lin International for RFP No. "P16-31 Professional Engineering Design Services for the Replacement of Bridge No. 1400-073 on Landing Road over NJ Transit and Morris Canal in the Township of Roxbury, Morris County, New Jersey, State Job No. 683632," in the amount of \$1,454,276.64; and

WHEREAS, an amended agreement was adopted on March 25, 2020 by Resolution No. 199 for additional work as requested by NJDOT, resulting in a new contract total of \$2,023,898.80, and again on November 10, 2021 by Resolution No. 2021-927 for additional work preparing bid documents for the demolition of all vacant building structures within the project limits to proceed with the project, resulting in a new contract total of \$2,089,346.07; and

**WHEREAS**, an amended agreement was adopted on February 23, 2022 by Resolution No. 2022-217 for additional work due to Right-of-Way acquisitions along with Licensed Site Remediation Professionals & Hazardous Material (LSRP/HAZMAT) services, resulting in a new contract total of \$2,723,712.31; and

**WHEREAS**, an amended agreement was adopted on June 28, 2023 by Resolution No. 2023-596 to perform additional utility work along with New Jersey Transit coordination and extending the term to December 31, 2024, hence, resulting in a new contract total of \$2,751,080.31; and

WHEREAS, an amended agreement was adopted on June 12, 2024 by Resolution No. 2024-529 for additional work for utility coordination with the Township of Roxbury and Jersey Central Power & Light along with preparation of a Project Authorization application and Sites Council presentation resulting in a new contract total of \$2,868,220.31; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to further increase the contract by \$38,244.00 for preparation of easement documents for Jersey Central Power & Light utility pole #NJ 331RU relocation and extending the term to December 31, 2025 with said funding to be drawn from account 04-216-24-953662-909 and added to the Certificate of Availability of Funds contract #168806.
