WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

According to apprenticeship.gov:

- An apprenticeship is an industry driven, high-quality career pathway where employers can develop and prepare their future workforce
- Individuals can obtain paid work experience, classroom instruction and nationally recognized credentials
- 94% of employers retain apprentices for full-time job opportunities after their apprenticeships are completed
- Since 2017 there has been an upward trend in apprenticeship opportunities



CREDENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES

- 4 college credits toward an AAS in Mechanical Engineering Technology
- OSHA 10 Certification
- Additional Certifications: 5 Level 1 NIMS certifications and SolidWorks
- Additional college credits may be received after completion of the apprenticeship

INTERVIEW OPPORTUNITIES

- Employers are ready to interview students for apprenticeship opportunities
- Career preparation assists students with mock interviews, resume writing and cover letters

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

After apprenticeship completion, apprentices may be offered a position where they can receive a benefits package, higher full-time salary, growth opportunities, additional trainings and certifications.

According to the Occupational Outlook Handbook, salaries range from \$45,000-\$65,000 after the completion of an apprenticeship, based upon skill level and certifications.
