St. John's Episcopal Church, Boonton

2007 \$39,688 Stained Glass

Grant Recipient: St. John's Episcopal Church, Boonton

Location: Boonton Town

St. John's Church was designed by noted ecclesiastical architect Richard Upjohn almost 150 years ago, the same architect who later designed Trinity Church on Wall Street in New York. The church itself is constructed in the vernacular carpenter gothic style of country parish churches. In 1892 a parish hall designed by Upjohn's son and working partner was added. The church building includes a number of significant stained glass windows including three by Lewis Comfort Tiffany and the Tiffany Studios.

The 2007 grant has assisted with the stabilization and preservation of six stained glass windows, some of which are by Tiffany, including re-leading, and refurbishment.
