Hendrik Doremus House

Grant Recipient: Montville Township

Location: Montville Twp.

Originally built in 1720, the house is a small one story example of vernacular Dutch residential architecture, and is one of the very few Dutch Stone Farmhouses that has remained with minimal alterations. George Washington had stayed in this house and his troops stayed in the tavern across the street.

In 2003, the Township received \$20,000 from the Trust Fund toward the design and contract drawings for the house. The 2004 grant has provided for site grading, excavation, installation of underground drainage and archaeological investigations.

The 2006 grant has provided for the replacement of the roofs, restoration of chimneys, fireplace surrounds, interior doors and hardware.
