

Succasunna Historic District

Grant Recipient: Roxbury Township Historical Society

Location: Roxbury Twp.

The Township of Roxbury was founded in 1740. The village of Suckasunning (place of the black rock) was located on one of the trails of the Lenni-Lenape Indians (the original people). The Indians of the Lenni-Lenape tribe who inhabited this area, long before the white settlers, established their burial ground on the north of what is now Main Street and it was discovered, in 1960, located beneath the Presbyterian Cemetery grounds. The Succasunna Historic District, of which the church is a central feature, represents economic development and growth of an 18th and mid-19th century village.

The 2010 and 2011 grants provided for a New Jersey and National Register Nomination for the Succasunna Historic District with an inventory of the proposed properties.
