The c. 1830 Union School House was built using German masonry techniques and included a school room on the second floor and a meeting space on the first floor. The building currently houses the Washington Township Historical Society and is listed on both the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places.

The 2014 grant completed a Preservation Plan with Code and Accessibility Review and a Structural Evaluation.

The 2017 grant provided for exterior restoration including window, doors, woodwork, porches and chimney repairs.

The 2018 grant completed Construction Documents for roof replacement.

The 2019 grant assisted with roof replacement including new cedar shingle main roof, copper porch roofs, and repointing of chimney.
