

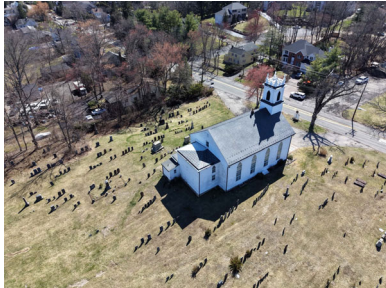

Location: East Hanover Twp.

The First Presbyterian Church of Hanover was the oldest religious organization in Morris County, established in 1718 in Whippany. During the revolutionary war, its original building was used as a hospital and burying ground for military casualties and victims of a small pox epidemic.

The current building (built in 1835 with Greek Revival massing) and burial ground are significant in the cultural and historical development of Hanover Village in the 18th and 19th Century.

After completing a Condition Assessment Report with a 2003 grant, the church replaced the slate roof with assistance from 3 grants in 2004, 2005 and 2006.

2007~2009 grants completed exterior restoration of all building façades, including wood siding and trim, windows, foundations and exterior painting.

The 2026 grant will assist with the acquisition of the historic church and burial ground property by East Hanover Township. The Township acquired this property in August 2025.
