Grant Recipient: Church of the Redeemer

Location: Morristown Town

The Parish House, built in 1926, is significant due to its association with the growth and development of Morristown, and as an architect-designed edifice that utilized the collegiate-influenced Gothic Revival style. The granite stone building was designed to be sympathetic to the more dominant Redeemer while also employing the latest construction technologies being widely used in the early 20th century, such as structural steel, terra cotta, and steel windows. The main roof is slate. The Parish House is contributing to the Morristown Historic District.

The 2011 Construction grant assisted with Phase I exterior restoration of the building's front façade to address the terra cotta and granite; the replacement of deteriorated steel lintels; restoration of metal windows at front elevation and priority conditions; restoration of the rose window; resetting of the terra cotta coping stones; and the replacement of the flat roof and associated flashings.

The 2012 and 2013 grants completed exterior restoration of the south, east and north elevations of the building, including masonry and terra cotta restoration.
