Waterloo Village

2012 \$22,257 District Expansion

Grant Recipient: Canal Society of New Jersey

Location: Mount Olive Twp.

Waterloo Village, located in Allamuchy Mt. State Park in Sussex and Morris Counties, is one of the best preserved Morris Canal sites in New Jersey. The Village is a key site for interpreting the relationship between industry, commerce, transportation and agriculture in mid-19th century New Jersey.

The 2012 grant provided for research and documentation to update the National Register nomination of Waterloo Village including the expansion of its current boundaries to include properties on the Morris County side of the river. A written summary included approximately 25 architectural and archaeological resources and their related elements.
