Grant Recipient: St. Peter's Mountain Lakes

Location: Mountain Lakes Boro.

The St. Peter's Church property consists of 1) the Main Church Building erected in 1926, with a Parish Hall added in 1955, and 2) the Rectory, which is a Hapgood residence built in 1916. Both buildings are contributing buildings to the Mountain Lakes Historic District. The Church is in the Gothic Revival style and the Rectory epitomizes a Hapgood house in the District, influenced by the Craftsman style. The two buildings exhibit many elements in the District that were vital in the town's planning. Both are set into the natural landscape and use materials such as stucco, slate and boulderstone. St. Peter's Church is highly visible from the Boulevard and is a widely used facility, serving as a center for community cultural events and activities.

The 2015 grant completed a Preservation Plan for the Church, Parish House and Rectory.

The 2017 grant provided for the replacement of the church building slate roofing and replacement of the storm water drainage system.
