Stanhope United Methodist Church

Location: Netcong Boro.

The Church is contributing to an expanded Stanhope Historic District, which was determined eligible for National Register listing. The 1917 Church was built of local stone in a Late Gothic Revival style. A short crenellated tower is the main focus of the façade. The walls are buttressed and green clay tiles are on the gable roof. The education building was added to the north side of the church in 1965. It is also constructed of local stone, with a flat roof.

A Preservation Plan and National Register Nomination for the Church were completed using a 2010 grant.

A 2011 grant has completed stained glass window preservation, as well as preparation of Construction Documents for restoration of the main roof and bell tower roof.

The 2012 grant has provided for the restoration of the Bell Tower Roof and the Bell Tower Lower Roof.

The 2015 grant assisted with work at the main roof.
