Location: Parsippany-Troy Hills Twp.

The house is a good example of a New Jersey vernacular late 18th-early 19th century farmhouse. It is the last structure of its type in the Township and one of the few 125 year-old or older buildings in the Township.

The Township completed a Preservation Plan for the house with a 2003 grant. A 2004 grant completed structural stabilization including repair of the stone foundation, basement windows and door and first floor framing, and non-construction activities including architectural services and archaeology.

The Township has completed a restoration of the exterior using a 2007 grant.

The 2009 grant was used to complete contract documents for interior restoration.

The 2010 grant completed interior restoration of the house to an 1849-1867 period of significance. The work included the upgrade of mechanical, electrical, plumbing (MEP) and fire protection systems.
