The Mt. Tabor Historic District, founded in 1869, is an example of a Methodist camp meeting ground and includes numerous stick-style buildings. The historic district retains 8 community buildings including the Tabernacle, Bethel, post office, fire house and library. The district is Certified as a New Jersey Eligible historic district.

The Mt. Tabor Historical Society used a 2011 grant to complete a Mt. Tabor Historic District Master Plan.

The 2012 grant completed a National Register Nomination for the Historic District.
