Grant Recipient: First Reformed Church of Pompton Plains

Location: Pequannock Twp.

The First Reformed Church of Pompton Plains consists of a complex of several components including the church building, Grace Chapel, and the manse, as well as two twentieth-century support buildings and a cemetery. The manse was constructed c.1788 as the home of Giles W. Mandeville and is a fine example of a Dutch-American stone house typical for the region in the late-eighteenth century. Since 1953 the home has served as the manse for the First Reformed Church of Pompton Plains.

The 2015 grant completed Construction Documents related to the exterior preservation and restoration of the house including roofing, windows and structural improvement.

The 2016 grant completed exterior restoration including masonry repointing and roof replacement at the porch.
