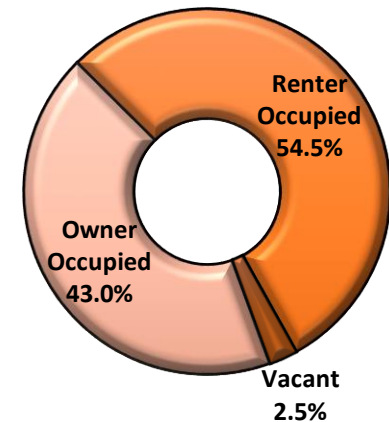
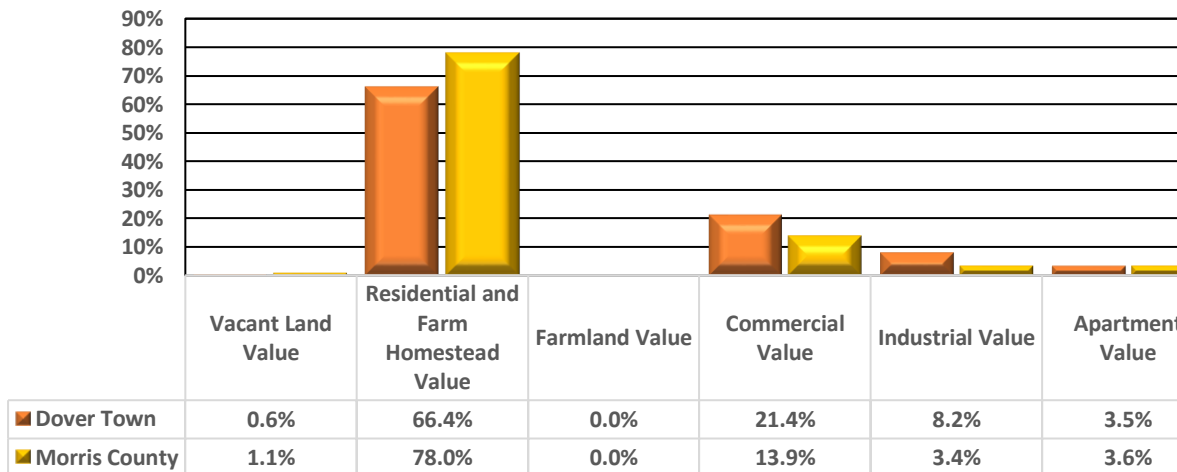

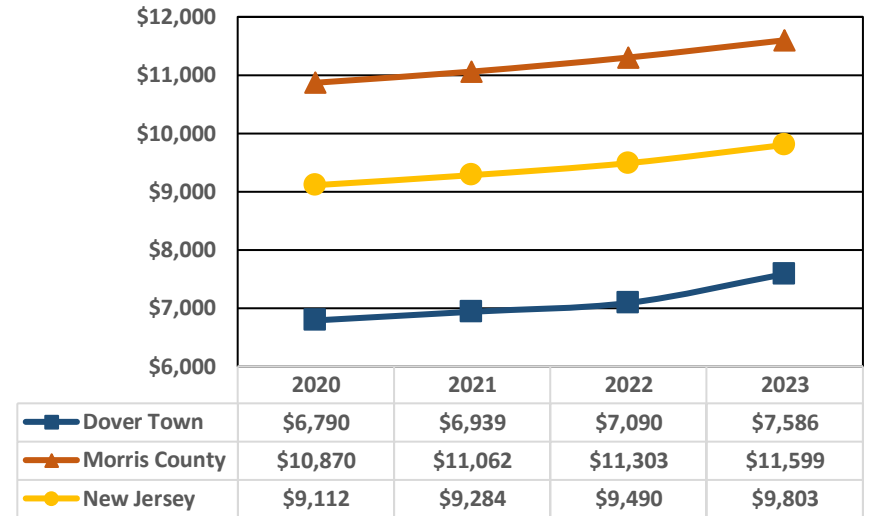
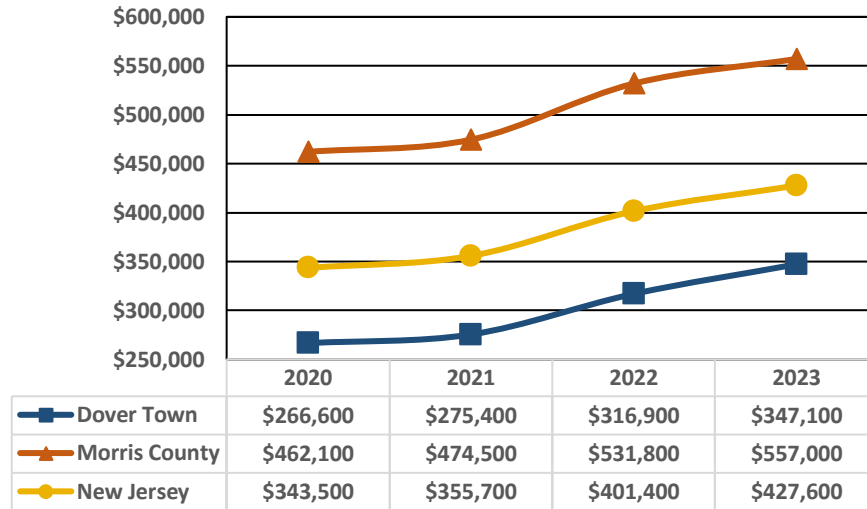

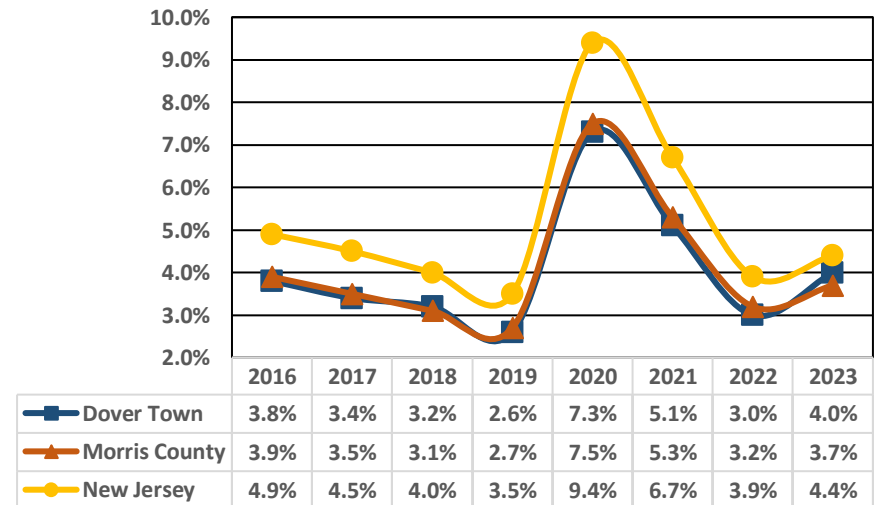
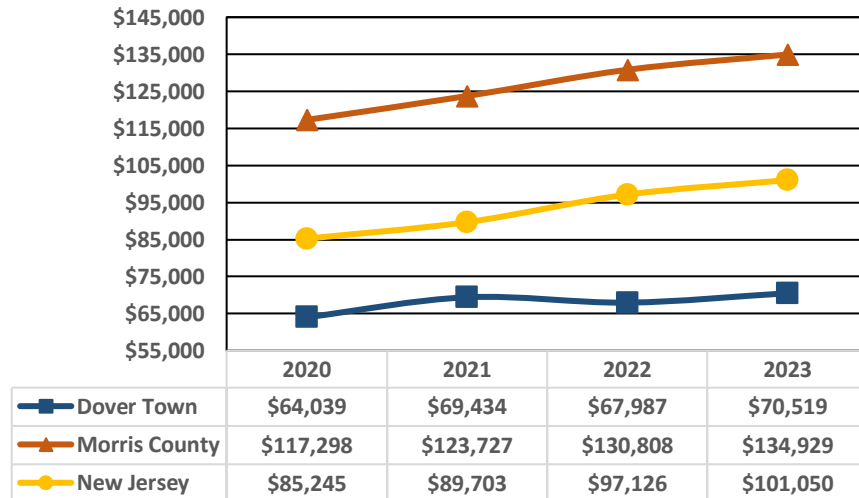

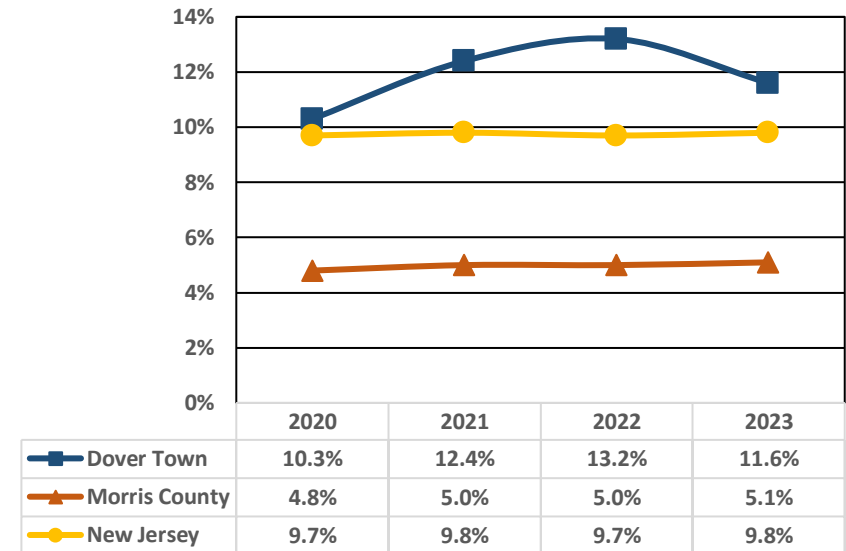
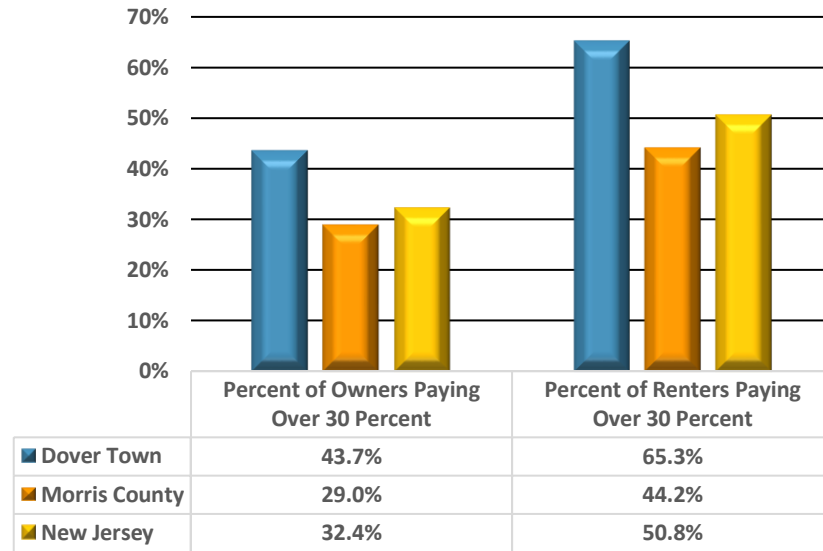
Unemployment Rate

Percent of Residents Paying More Than 30 Percent of Income on Housing

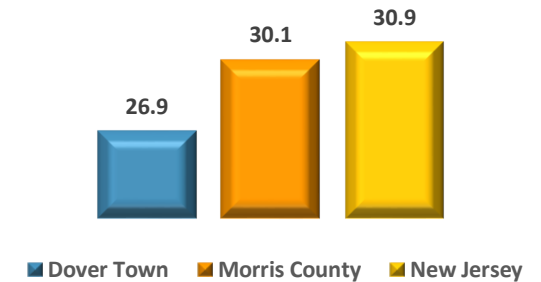
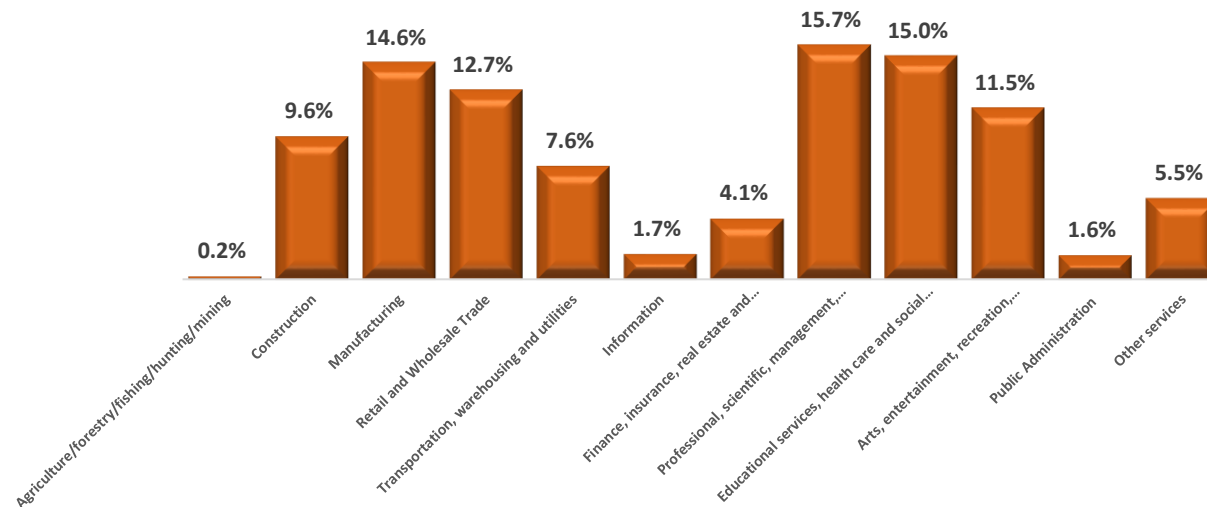
Percent Below Poverty Level

Mean Travel Time to Work (minutes)

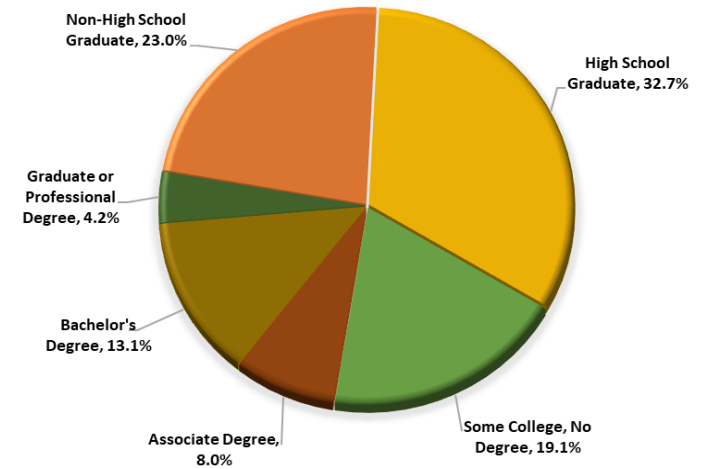
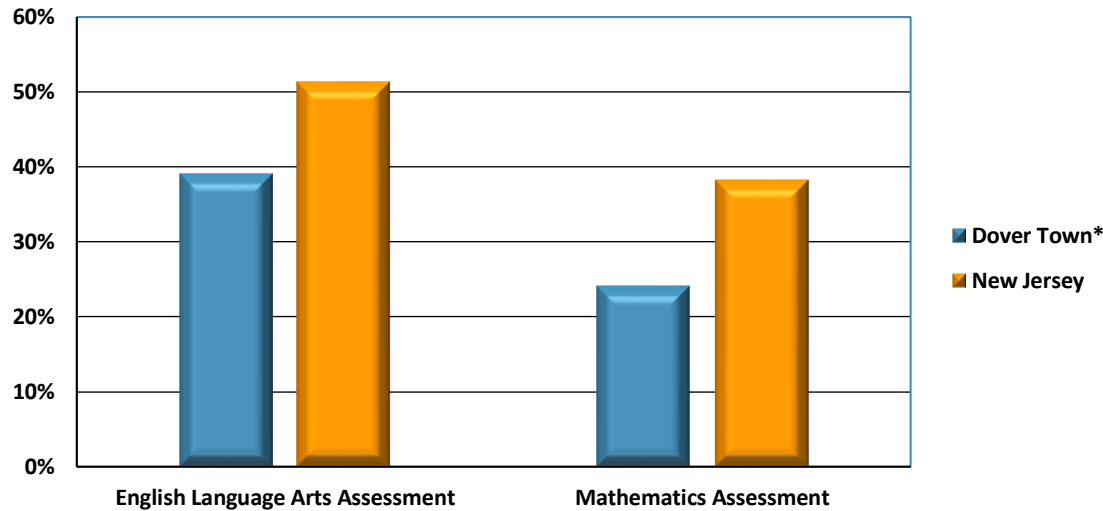

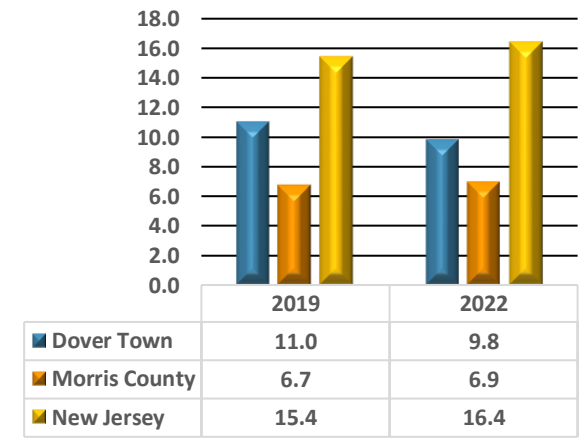
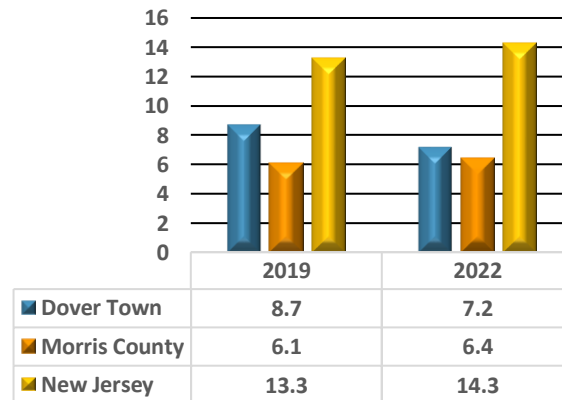
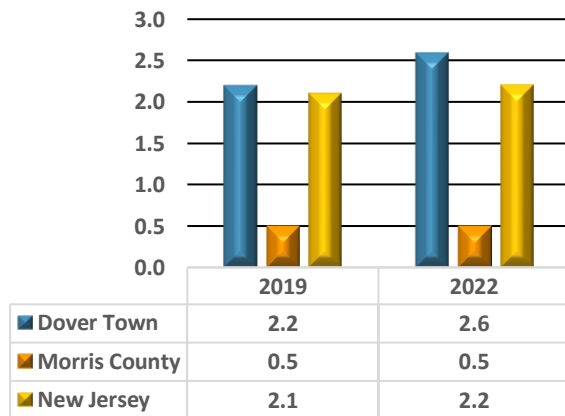
