L'Ecole Dr. Helen Miller Residence and Office was constructed in 1873 to serve as a one-room schoolhouse. The building became the home and office of Dr. Helen Miller, an early pioneer in female cancer detection and screening. The building is listed on the National and State Registers of Historic Places.

A Preservation Plan was completed with assistance from a 2011 grant that included structural and mechanical / electrical / plumbing evaluation.

A 2013 Construction grant has completed partial exterior restoration of the building including: restoration of the front porch, removal of the siding at the front (east) elevation, and repairs to the asphalt shingle roof and drainage.

The 2015 and 2016 grants assisted with roof restoration, removal of aluminum siding, doors repair and replacement and carpentry.

The 2017 and 2018 grants provided for interior rehabilitation including utility upgrades.

The 2020 grant assisted with interior restoration including repairs, rehabilitate of an existing restroom to create a barrier-free restroom, electrical, lighting and plumbing improvements.

The 2024 grant will provide for electrical upgrades and new porch gutter.
