The "Twin Oaks" Frelinghuysen Mansion, designed by McKim, Mead & White, has been the home of the Morris Museum since 1964. The neo-Georgian structure and landscaping collectively create the impression of opulence characteristic of the golden age of the historic "Normandy Heights" area of Morris Township.

The museum completed a Facility Infrastructure Analysis with assistance of a 2003 grant from the Trust Fund. The museum also completed electrical upgrades with a 2004 grant from the Trust Fund.

The 2015 grant completed a Preservation Plan, including code and accessibility review and structural evaluation.

The 2016 Construction Documents grant completed Construction Documents for restoration of the slate roof, dormers and chimneys, and the porch roof.

The 2021 and 2022 grants restored the 100+ year old slate roof, replaced the flat porch roof, repaired the balustrade, and painted the exterior.

The 2025 grant completed Construction Documents for stabilization and restoration of the historic portico entrance to reflect its historic appearance.

The 2026 grant will provide for Phase 2 Exterior Restoration including the restoration of the porte cochere entrance to its historic appearance.
