Grant Recipient: First Reformed Church of Pompton Plains

Location: Pequannock Twp.

The Church complex includes several components including the Church building (c. 1711, rebuilt 1937,) the Carpenter Gothic Grace Chapel and the Dutch stone Manse (Giles Mandeville House, 1870s) as well as a cemetery and two 20th century support buildings. The complex is listed on the the New Jersey and National Register of Historic Places.

The 2009 grant helped complete a Preservation Plan focusing on the exterior of the buildings and their structural systems; and a National Register Nomination.

The 2013 Construction grant completed the restoration of the Chapel addressing the exterior and structure.

The 2014 grant provided for the exterior restoration of the Church building.

The 2015 grant upgraded roof drainage and restoration of exterior woodwork at the Church building.

The 2026 grant will provide for the restoration of the wrought iron fence that dates from the 1920s.
