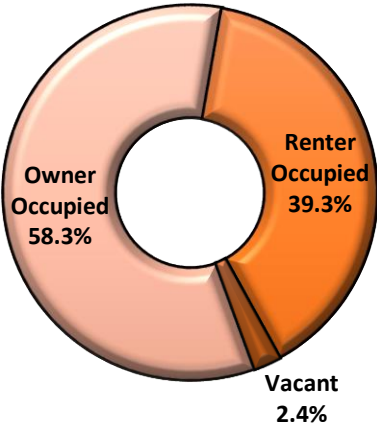
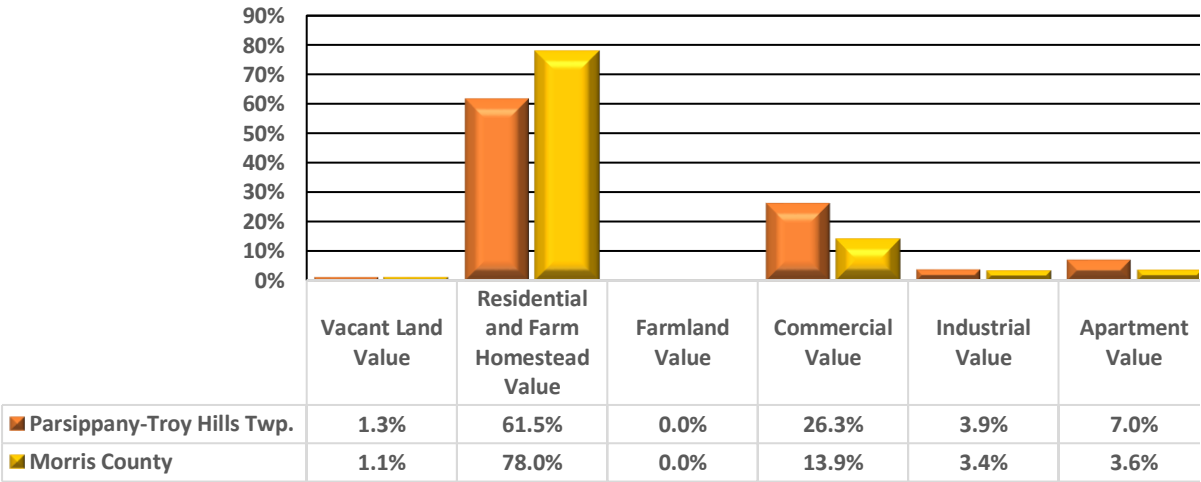

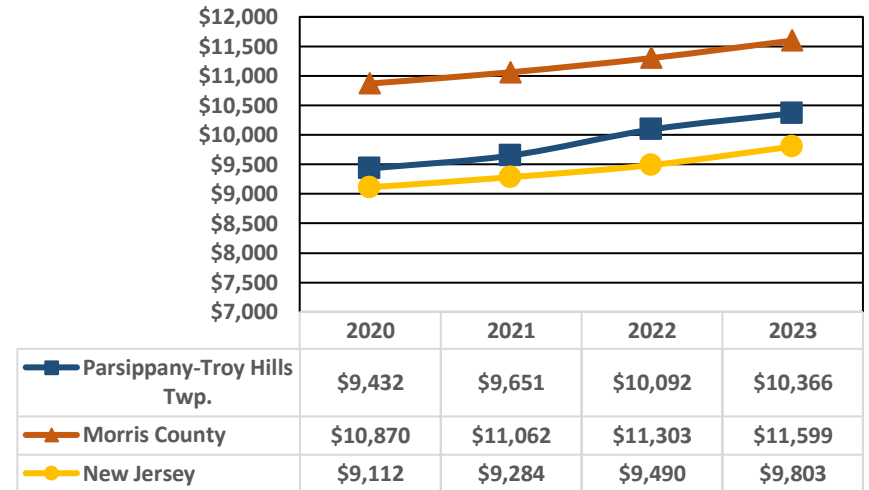
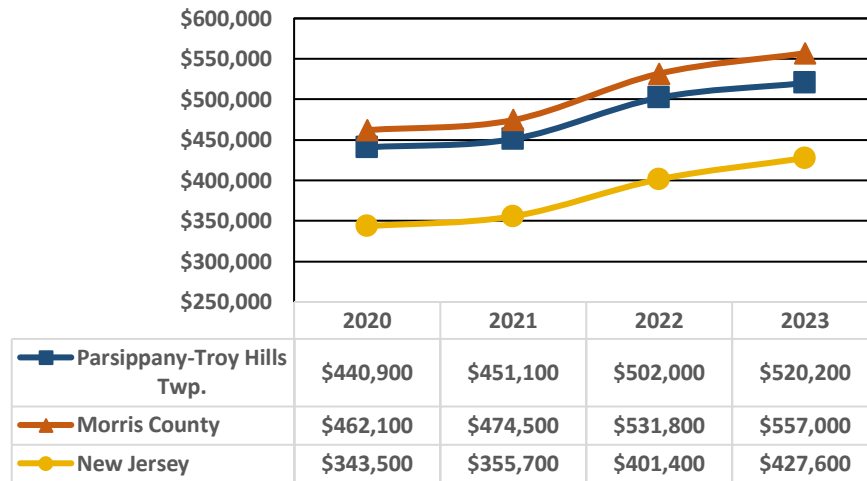
Parcel Values as a Percentage of Total Value      Housing Occupancy

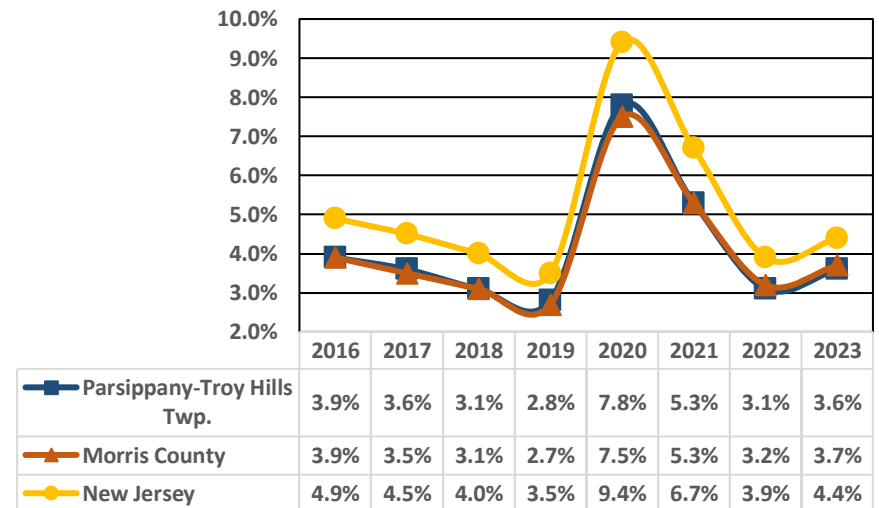
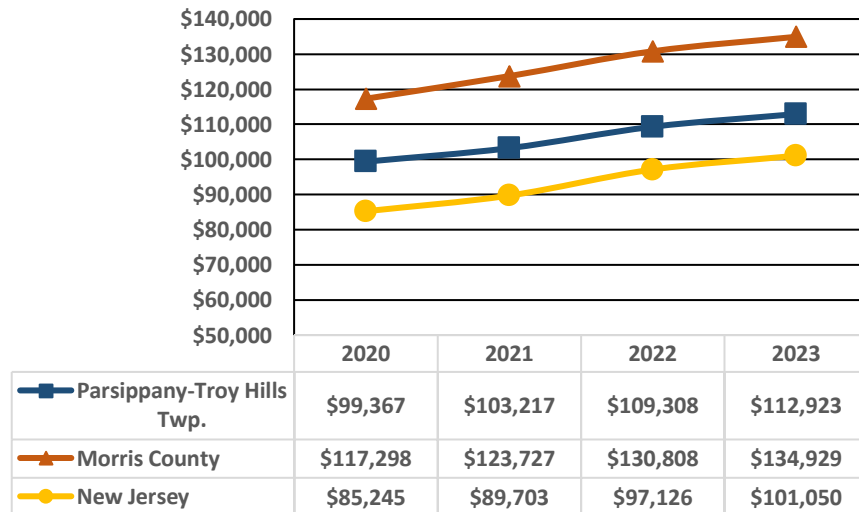

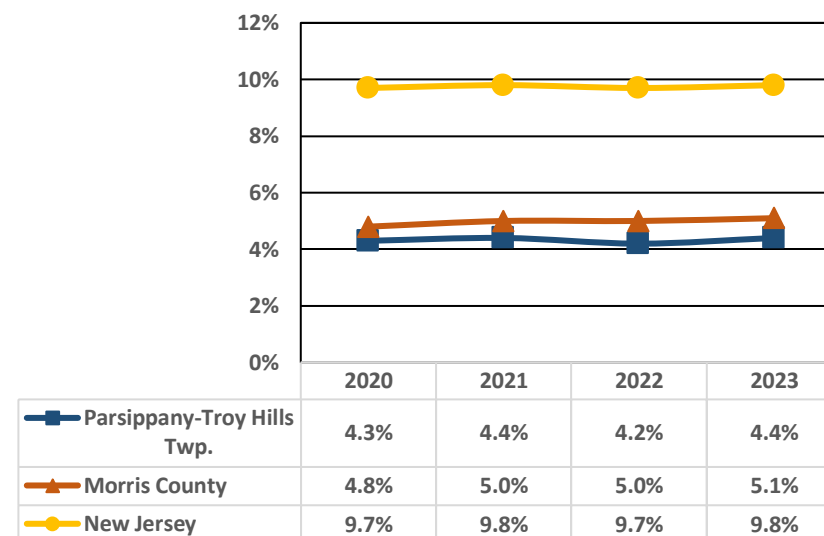
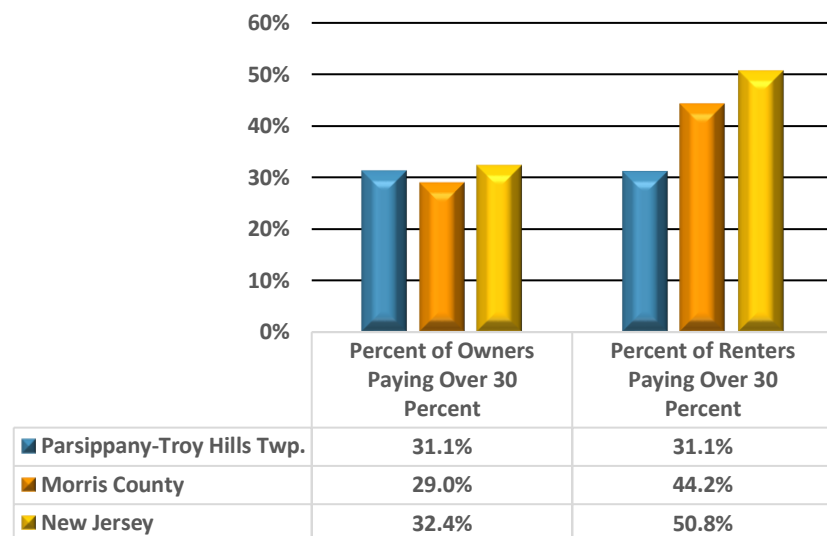

## Percent of Residents Paying More Than 30 Percent of Income on Housing

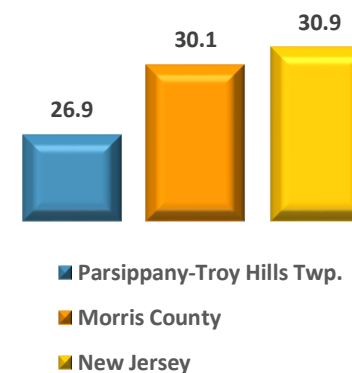
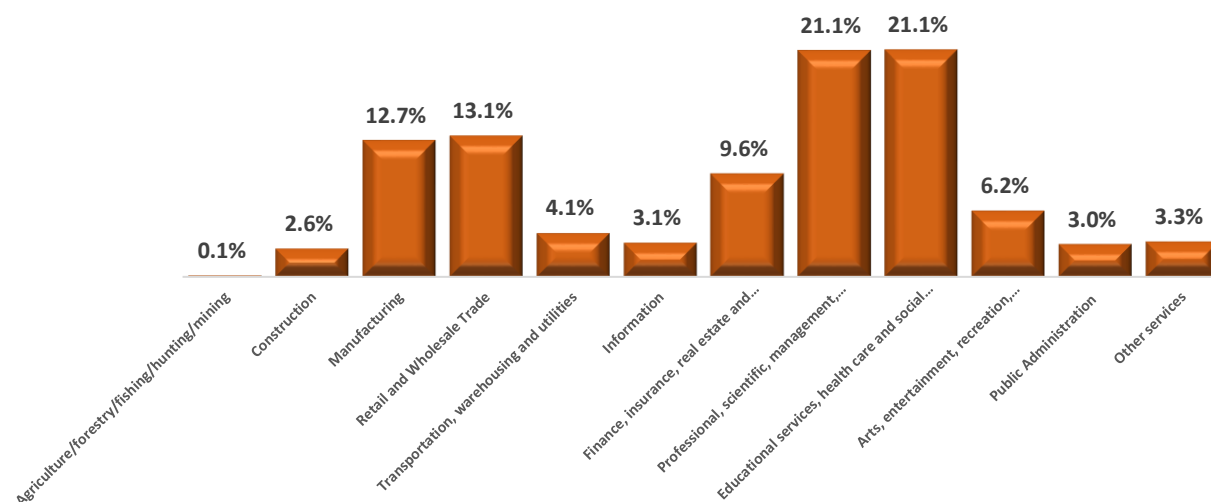
## Percent Below Poverty Level

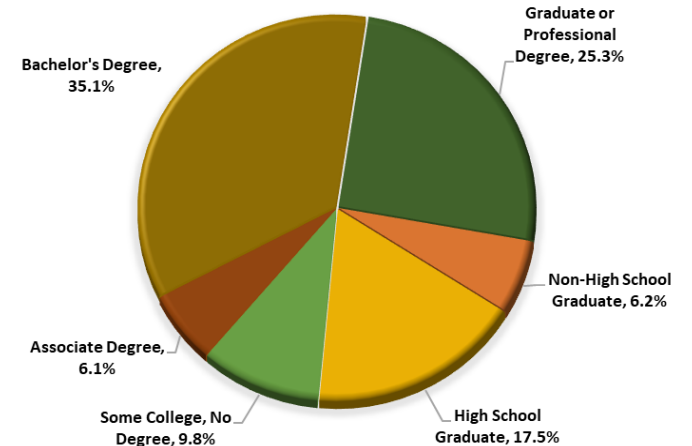
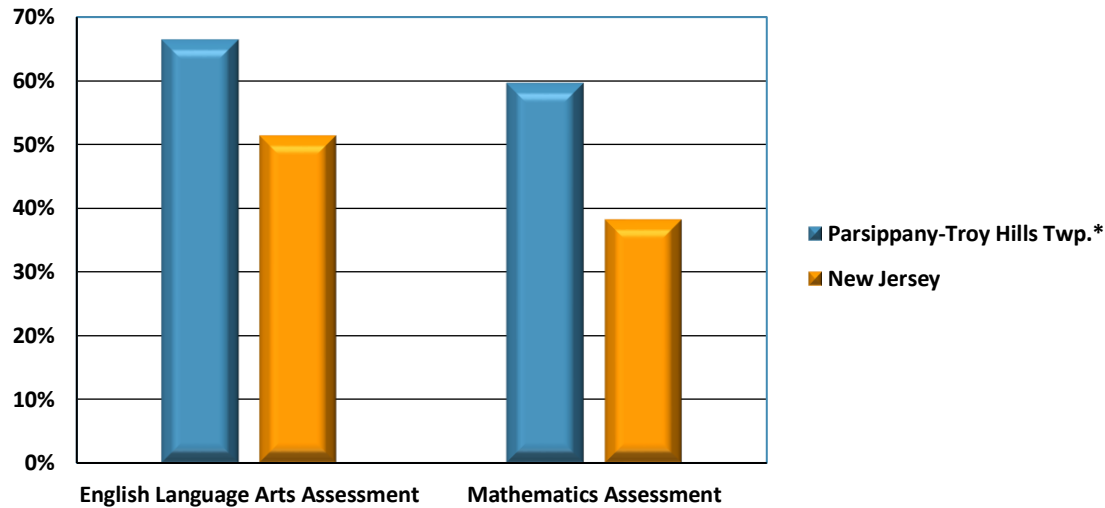

(=>25 years)*



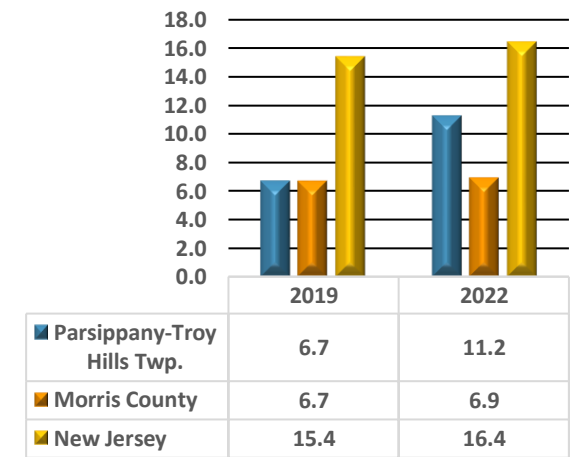
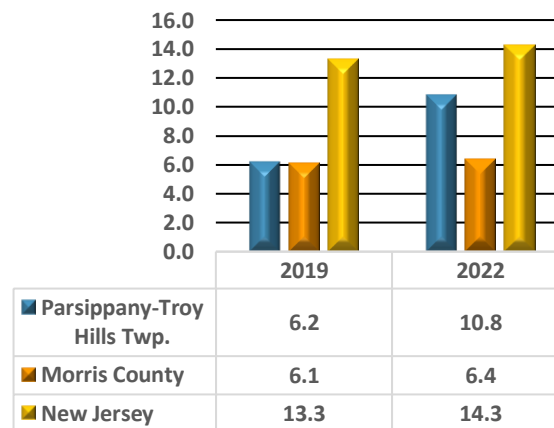
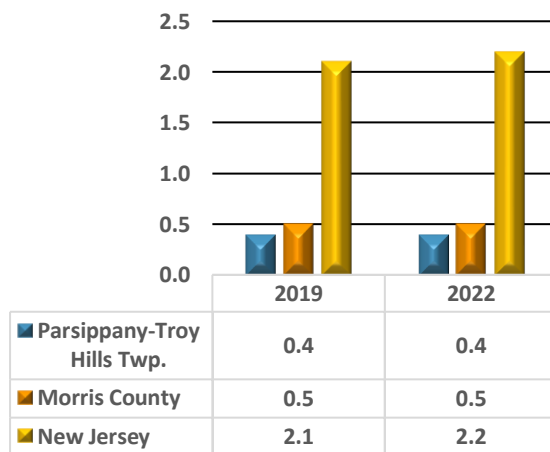
